CALIFORNIA LEGAL ALERT October 5, 2017

California's Division of Occupational Safety and Health ("Cal-OSHA") recently increased its penalties in response to Federal OSHA's increased penalty hikes last year. These new penalties apply to all citations issued on or after **September 14, 2017**.

	<u>Previous Penalty</u>	<u>New Penalty</u>
Regulatory Violations	\$7,000 max	\$12,471 max per violation
General Violations	\$7,000 max	\$12,471 max per violation
Serious Violations	\$25,000 max	\$25,000 max per violation

- Regulatory Violations: permit, posting, record-keeping, and reporting violations.
- <u>General Violations</u>: violations that are not serious in nature, but relate to employees' occupational safety and health.
- <u>Serious Violations</u>: violations that create a realistic possibility of death or serious physical harm to employees.

	<u>Previous Penalty</u>	<u>New Penalty</u>
Willful & Repeat Violations	\$5,000	\$8,908 minimum per violation
Willful & Repeat Violations	\$70,000	\$124,709 max per violation

New fines will also have a cost-of-living component that will entail annual increases starting January 1, 2018.
